

## **FASTWEB launches *Tutoricabile***

### **For the first time Internet at 6 or 20 Mbit/s and telephone on a prepaid basis with no access charge**

*Milan, May 16, 2006* – FASTWEB launched today *Tutoricabile*, a new service that further enriches its offer for residential users. *Tutoricabile* is the first-ever rechargeable Internet and Telephone service targeting people who want to manage their telecommunications spending themselves without giving up the superior speed and quality of FASTWEB services.

*Tutoricabile* is intended for the new user segment of young couples, singles and anyone interested in fixed telephone and Internet services, who keep a close watch on their spending. The typical *Tutoricabile* user will be a person who spends little time at home and uses fixed TLC only for specific purposes. A simple, non-invasive solution, *Tutoricabile* meets the need for a practical, efficient and cost-effective service: there is no access fee and the package is self-installing.

*So now, thanks to FASTWEB, access-free high-speed Internet and telephone are available on a pay-per-use basis, with an easy-to-install modem configured for Wi-Fi navigation, to which the PC and cordless phone connect on a wireless basis. Here's how:*

To enjoy the traditional quality of FASTWEB telephony and connectivity on a **pay-per-use** basis –Internet at a certified\* incoming rate of up to 6 Mbit/s and a transmission rate of 1 Mbit/s –*Tutoricabile* users have to purchase the prepaid cards, for 25, 50 or 100 Euro, from authorized dealers or directly on FASTWEB's commercial website. For people who already have a line installed and want to keep their number, the activation charge is 49 Euro and includes a **cordless** phone and **modem** on a free loan basis; customers who require a new FASTWEB number pay an activation fee of 148 Euro. The modem is already configured for Wi-Fi navigation (the *MegaInternet senza fili* option has a one-time charge of 49 Euro) and comes with a cordless phone dock.

*Tutoricabile*, the latest addition to FASTWEB's service portfolio, is an innovative off-the-shelf offer. This appealing and practical commercial synthesis of the activities of FASTWEB Labs delivers the flexibility of the network and IP technology in a simple, easy-to-use solution, complete with stylish accessories.

Pay-per-use Internet: 1.50 Euro per hour  
Telephone: 0.15 Euro on response – 0.15 Euro per minute

With the *Super ADSL* option (one-time charge of 80 Euro) users can boost their **Internet incoming access rate to 20 Mbit/s\***.
